Here at St Vincent's Furniture Project, we take in donations of good quality essential furniture in order to redistribute it directly to individuals and families in Sheffield who are struggling to make a house a home.

Amongst those that we support are people coming out of homelessness, refugees, families escaping domestic violence, or those who are simply struggling to make ends meet due to the current economic climate. All of these people share one thing in common: the right to a comfortable, safe, and stable home environment.

We cannot do the work we do without the kind donations of furniture from the local community. We offer a free-of-charge collection service to anyone within the city limits, and our doors are open for drop-offs of bedding, kitchenware, and smaller furniture items.

Our bookings service is run largely by volunteers, and we couldn't make this happen without them! We are often just as in need of people's time as we are their furniture, and welcome inquiries about voluntary opportunities.
